3.4.4.2 Organizational Management

(a) System Management

ISO 9000	–	Quality Management Systems
ISO 14000	–	Environmental Management Systems (EMS)
OHSAS 18000	–	Occupational Health & Safety Systems

For Possession of current ISO 9000 / ISO 14000 / OHSAS 18000 certification. 30.0 points per each of such certification will be allocated.

System Management Certification shall be obtained from a certifying body accredited by Sri Lanka Accreditation Board (SLAB), the National Accreditation Authority established under Act No. 32 of 2005, or accreditation body which is signatory to IAF, MLA (International Accreditation Forum, Multilateral Recognition Arrangement) for the particular scope / sector (construction).

Accreditation shall include annual surveillance assessment with onsite witness assessment of certified construction companies / agencies.

As and when necessary any non-compliances shall be reviewed by the local authority SLAB

Mandatory requirement of possession of System Management :

- For Grade CS2 – ISO 9000, ISO 14000, OHSAS 18000
- For Grade CS1 – ISO 9000, ISO 14000, OHSAS 18000
- For Grade C1, C2, C3 – ISO 9000

(b) Construction Safety & Occupational Health

(i) Mandatory requirement of engagement of Construction Safety & Occupational Health Managers / Construction Safety & Occupational Health Officers / Construction Safety & Occupational Health Supervisors:

- For Grade CS2 & CS1 – 01 Construction Safety & Occupational Health Manager
02 Construction Safety & Occupational Health Officers
03 Construction Safety & Occupational Health Supervisors
- For Grade C1 – 01 Construction Safety & Occupational Health Officer
02 Construction Safety & Occupational Health Supervisors
- For Grade C2 & C3 – 01 Construction Safety & Occupational Health Supervisor

Point allocation is given in Table 11.

For grades CS2 & CS1, the above staff should be on full time permanent basis with EPF payments.

For grade C1, Construction Safety & Occupational Health Officer could be engaged on consultancy basis with a binding consulting agreement and the two Construction Safety & Occupational Health Supervisors should be on permanent basis with EPF

payments. (attested payment vouchers should be submitted to prove the service obtained)

For grades C2 & C3, Construction Safety & Occupational Health Supervisor could be engaged on consultancy basis with a binding consulting agreement (attested payment vouchers should be submitted to prove the service obtained).

CIDA specifically expects that the construction Contractors of grades CS2, CS1 & C1 shall be actively involved in dengue eradication on the site / office & it's surroundings and are active members in the Dengue eradication task force established in the CIDA. (Two points will be allocated for each of the above 2 activities)

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| Construction Safety & Occupational Health Manager | - A basic Degree and
- A six (06) months Construction Safety & Occupational Health (CSOH) Diploma course conducted by CIDA
OR
- A basic Degree and
- A six (06) months duration Construction Safety & Occupational Health (CSOH) Diploma recognized by CIDA |
| Construction Safety & Occupational Health Officer | - A six (06) months Construction Safety & Occupational Health (CSOH) Diploma course conducted by CIDA
OR
- A Diploma in CSOH of duration not less than six (06) months recognized by CIDA |
| Construction Safety & Occupational Health Supervisor | - A four (04) months Construction Safety & Occupational Health (CSOH) Certificate course conducted by CIDA
OR
- A Certificate in CSOH of duration not less than three (03) months recognized by CIDA |
