RESTRUCTURING OF TRAINING CURRICULUM OF CIDA

CIDA, the regulating authority and the apex state body responsible for the development and regulation of the construction sector in Sri Lanka, operates 03 (three) training arms namely, Construction Equipment Training Centre – (CETRAC), Operator Training College (OTC) and Center for Housing Planning and Building (CHPB). In order to attract Public Private Partnership (PPP) programmes, CIDA has decided to rejuvenate and restructure the existing training programmes in terms of improving the effectiveness and efficiency while maintaining the quality of outputs. In this vein, it would be essential to reanalyze the current course modules and validate them to suit the current trends of the smart world.

Scope of the Assignment

The scope is, but not limited to analyze the current context of training programmes of CETRAC, OTC and CHPB propose revamping / restructuring avenues for the modules / contents to deliver an enhanced output with shorter time durations if appropriate but with wider scope and possible diversifications:

(1) Analyzing the course contents and submission of a Preliminary report on restructuring and investment plans	03 months
(2) Refining the proposals liaising with the management upon approvals and crafting implementation plans	01months
(3) Implementation programmes with the assistance of detailed staff upon approvals	02 months

Terms & Conditions

- 1.0 The assignment will initially will be for a period of 06 months and extendable upon a management review.
- 2.0 A remuneration of **Rs. 2,500 per Hour** with a maximum limit of 30 Hrs per week shall be made subject to monthly basis.
- 3.0 To be entitled for the payment, the Consultant shall ensure that his obligations under the Scopes of the Consultancy Service are fulfilled.
- 4.0 If CIDA is not satisfied with the performance of the Consultant, CIDA has the authority to make deductions from the monthly remunerations giving due reason/s for doing so.
- 5.0 Office Space at Training Centers, transport facilities (between centers and stakeholder / client territories whenever necessary) and a Laptop Computer with reasonably limited internet facilities will be provided. Reimbursement of Telephone bills to the limit applicable to Middle Management level of CIDA will also be allowed.
- 6.0 All work carried out for this task remains a property of CIDA and must not be disclosed to any other person or organization without written permission of the Chairman of the CIDA.

A suitably qualified individual, a citizen of Sri Lanka, with exposure to Training in the Construction Industry fields with for more than 20 year period with basic minimum qualifications equal to Diploma Level will be proposed for this assignment. (Preference will be given to personnel with training experience in the state sector or a similar recognized private sector training organizations)
